

<p style="text-align: center;">BRITISH UNIVERSITIES INDOOR ARCHERY CHAMPIONSHIPS 2009</p>

Please find enclosed the pre-event information for the Indoor Archery Championships being held at the Sir David Wallace Sports Hall(SDW), Loughborough University (01509 223864) on Saturday 7th March 2009.

There will be three sessions of two details. Session 1 at 08:30, Session 2 at 12:00 and Session 3 at 15:30. Target Lists for the three sessions to follow.

Please note that only those listed on the Target Lists can participate and substitutions cannot be made prior to or on the day under any circumstances.

RULES: GNAS rules will apply. There will be no formal equipment inspection before the tournament, but competitors are cautioned that breaking the Rules of Shooting could lead to immediate disqualification. There will be no time control other than spot checks by the Field Captain on individual archers. Further details relating to the Rules and Regulations can be found on the BUCS website.

DRESS: Competitors are asked to wear sensible clothing for the shoot, conforming as closely as possible to GNAS dress regulations. Competitors are asked to note that only soft, non-marking soles will be allowed in the sports halls, and you will not be allowed to compete barefoot.

PACKING: Archers concerned about pass-throughs should bring their own packing material.

TROPHIES: Please note that it is the responsibility of last year's winning team to return all trophies to the event engraved and polished ready to be re-presented.

MEDALS: Awards will be made to the winning individuals in the Men's and Women's Championships in both Recurve and Compound for the Championship & Shield Categories. There will also be an award made to the winning Overall Team and Shield Team. The scores for the Overall Team shall be ascertained by adding together the respective scores of the four leading individuals of each competing institution in the recurve category across the Championship and Shield categories. The Shield Team shall be ascertained by adding together the respective scores of the three leading individuals of each competing institution in the recurve category in the Shield category ONLY. Teams with less than the required numbers will be considered on request and provided an entry has been received.

REGISTRATION ON THE DAY: The Registration Desk for BUCS Archery will be on the Balcony area of the SDW. A member of SDW staff will be at the main reception desk to guide you in the right direction. The registration desk will be manned from 07:45 till 18:00.

There will also be a selection of maps available to aid in directing competitors. The entire balcony will also be available for spectators.

Merlins will also have a stand located in the hall if you need to purchase anything (emergency or otherwise).

FLOW OF COMPETITORS: We ask that competitors try to turn up 1/2 hour before the start of their session. This is to enable us to get everyone registered, and also to allow time for you to set up your equipment. If time is short, we will be asking competitors to set up their equipment outside of the Hall for a quick changeover. There are two main double doors into the shooting hall itself. At changeover time, if outgoing competitors could use the fire doors at the front of the hall, and incoming competitors the main doors into the hall this will cut down on the crush.

COMPETITION INFORMATION: As the SDW is so large, we will have 5 judges presiding at the competition, Chairman of Judges Pam Tonkin, Judges, Chrissie Mortlock, Geoff Malyon, Mark Stuart and Sue Richards

There is a large amount of space behind the shooting and waiting lines in the Hall. We would appreciate it if competitors could leave at least the back metre clear as a walkway.

There will be double scoring on each boss. In order to keep the scores up to date and to get the results out quickly, there will be running slips at the end of each dozen which require each arrow score to be recorded there will also be a number of LS Archery Club (and other BUTTS clubs) kindly acting as runners. We would appreciate it if you could co-operate with them. They will aim to collect scores every dozen. Running results sheets will be published every dozen these will be compounded with all the previous sessions at that same stage (leader board style).

PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY: The prize giving ceremony will be held straight after the competition at 18:30 in the Sir David Wallace Sports Hall. Our Lady Paramount (Leicestershire & Rutland County Archery Association Secretary) will be presenting the medals, raffle prizes and gifts.

POST EVENT ACTIVITIES: For those competitors not shooting there are a number of activities that can be done in and around Loughborough. There are a selection of shops and bars at the Students' Union (2 minute walk from the SDW),. There are 15 bars on campus of which 8 are in the Students' Union building.

Off campus the Town Centre is only about 1 mile away, and a regular bus service goes from the Students' Union into town. There are a range of shops, as well as a market on a Saturday. There is also a cinema in the centre of town.

Just on the outskirts of Loughborough, near the train station (Wymeswold) there is a karting centre. Nottingham, Leicester and Derby are all around 20 minutes drive from campus and have a larger shopping district, as well as activities such as Ice Skating, Bowling, and Quasar.

There will be a post event party held at the Students' Union straight after the awards ceremony, we have booked out the Lava Room/Nightclub.

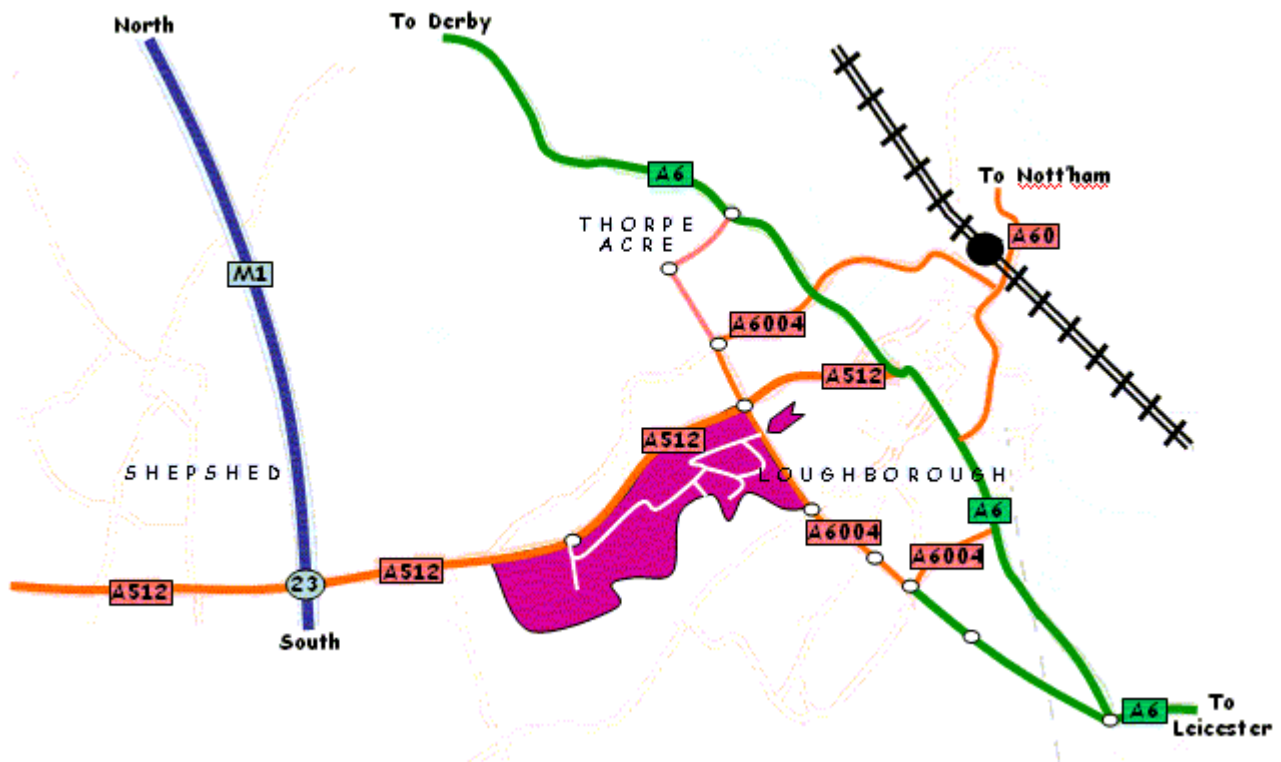

DIRECTIONS

The map below shows the road routes into Loughborough:



From the North:

Take **M1** to Junction **23** - **A512 Loughborough**

Left at the **roundabout** signposted to **Loughborough**

Follow the road, straight across two sets of traffic lights (past the Quality Inn and Harvesters)

Straight over the **roundabout**

Right at the next **roundabout**

Immediate **right** turn onto **Campus**

From the South:

Take **M1** to Junction **23** - **A512 Loughborough**

Right at the **roundabout** signposted to **Loughborough**

Follow the road, straight across two sets of traffic lights (past the Quality Inn and Harvesters)

Straight over the **roundabout**

Right at the next **roundabout**

Immediate **right** turn onto **Campus**

From the A6 West:

Turn **right** at the **roundabout** with 3M and Barclays on (signposted University, Colleges and Hospital)

Left at the next **roundabout** onto **Epinal Way**

Straight over the next **two roundabouts**

Immediate **right** turn onto **Campus**

From the A6 South:

Straight over the **roundabout** by Quorn onto the **Epinal Way Extension** (signposted to the University)

Straight over the next four roundabouts

Turn **left** after the **second** set of **pedestrian lights** onto Campus (the big yellow brick building is the SDW!)

From Nottingham:

From the A60 at Loughborough Train Station go **straight** over the **traffic lights**

Turn **left** at the **traffic lights** after the humpback bridge onto **King Street**

Follow King Street to the end and turn **left** at the **T-junction**

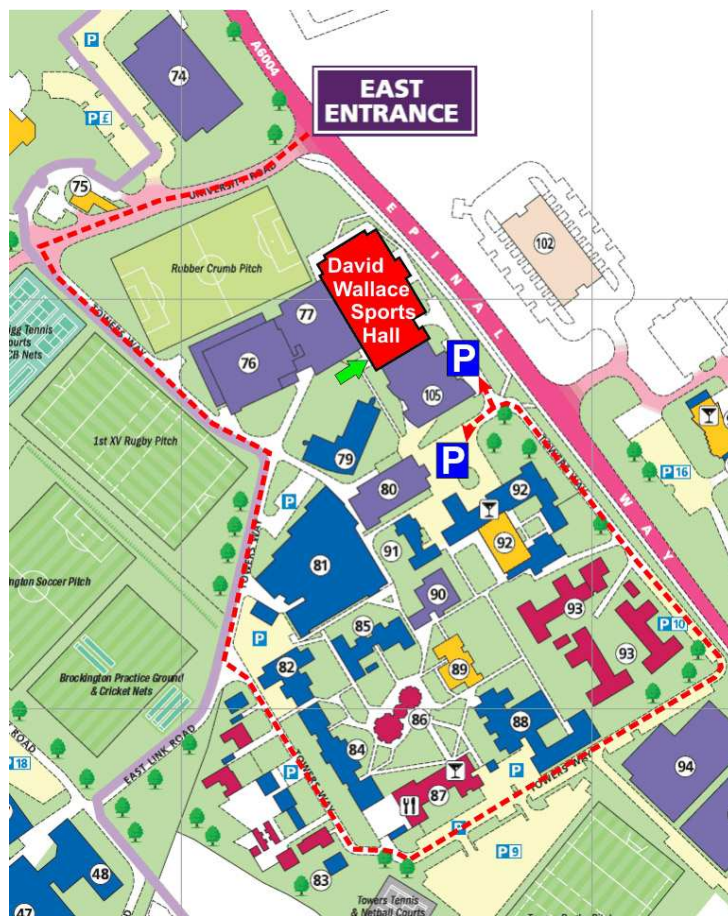
Right at the **traffic lights** next to the TA Centre onto **Shelthorpe Road**

Right at the **roundabout** (with McDonalds on)

Straight over the next **two roundabouts**

Turn **left** after the **second** set of **pedestrian lights** onto Campus (the big yellow brick building is the SDW!)

ON CAMPUS



PARKING: If coming by car/minibus you will have to use the main entrance of the University. On turning off Epinal Way, get into the right hand lane for the barriers. Security at the gatehouse have been told about the competition and will give you a parking permit and directions to the Sir David Wallace Sports Hall (SDW). Car parks 11 and 12 have been reserved specifically for BUCS Archery. You'll need to ensure that you hang the permit from the rear-view mirror when parked so that security won't fine/clamp your vehicle. At the exit barrier you'll need to wave your permit at the person in the gatehouse to get out. The gatehouse is manned 24 hours.

BY TRAIN:

The nearest railway station is Loughborough. There is a shuttle bus (#7) direct from the station onto Campus every 10 minutes. The bus stop on campus stops near the roundabout on the map on the previous page. The journey takes about 15 minutes. There is also a taxi rank outside the station, it will cost about £5.

BY AIR:

East Midlands Airport is approximately 7 miles away from Loughborough. There are many taxi companies at the airport the fare is approximately £16 and it takes about ½ hour. There is also an airline shuttle bus that goes to Loughborough Train Station (#AL5) every ½ hour - it takes about 35 minutes.
