1) BUCS OUTDOORS:

a) The team lists are required to be in by Thursday 26th May, in addition to normal list criteria, qualifying scores will need to be in by Wednesday.

Action: A.C. will send a list BUCS team list to the AU.

b) A final qualifying competition will be held on Tuesday 25th May, a committee member will need to hold the session beginning at 15:00.

Action: B.C. will hold the session on Tuesday 25th May, from 15:00 to 19:00 at Towers Pitch.

2) BUTTS OUTDOORS:

a) It was agreed that five people were needed to set up the day before (Friday 20th May). Five people will be required to set up. Items to set up include the target stand location markers, Gazebo and Barbeque.

Action: T.C., J.W., T.C., J.E. and Kimberley Taylor will be setting up for next day's competition at 17:30.

- b) T.C. explains that a trailer will be arriving at Holywell Pitch at o8:00 on Saturday 21st May. All members of the club will be expected to arrive for this to help set up targets.
- c) T.C. confirms that J.W., Chris Dobbs and Dave Corlett will be required to judge for the competition.

3) FUND RAISING:

a) Volleyball England has yet to continue conversation on their proposal for a small archery completion hosted by us. In the event that Volleyball England is still interested, the long IMS arrows will need to be fixed.

Actions: J.E. will continue to see if Volleyball England is still interested in this competition. T.C. will have a look at the longer IMS arrows to see what can be done.

4) SOCIALS:

a) Due to E.H.'s absence, details on the paintballing socials were not discussed however, the committee agreed that E.H. should email the club explaining details and asking if more people wanted to come.

- b) There was one volunteer to hold the novice barbeque; if there are no more volunteers soon then the committee decided that they will think about organizing it themselves.
- c) There was interest in watching the new "Pirates of the Caribbean" film at the cinema at any time after "18:30", various members of the committee will check times and more action will take place when a suitable time is found.

5) COLOURS:

a) J.E. and T.C. explained to the rest of the committee what club colours were and how they were achieved. There was a brief discussion about who deserved what award.

T.C will look at BUCS scores to see who achieved scores worthy of colour awards.
