- Finalise end of year club spending:
 - o Everything on list has been finalised and sourced:
 - Distance markers cannot be bought, instead materials must be bought and markers custom made
 - Recurve arrows in next years budget instead
 - After going through current trainer bows, purchase more 68" and 70" beginner limbs in case of an influx of novices with a high draw length again.
 - Focus on improving quality of intermediate kit rather than purchasing more beginner kit.
 - After going through current trainer bows, need to replace most of the beginner bow strings. 16 strings removed from equipment so 16 should be purchased but need to check lengths.
 - Tennis tape to extend shooting line indoors for novices.
 - o Andrew has been contacted to confirm purchases, no response. Assume spending is okay since the AU is already aware of plan to spend remaining funds before the end of the year.
 - Combination of club ordering items through invoice or members purchasing items and being reimbursed.
 - Lots of items being ordered from Merlins, easier to do a single large order and have it invoiced.
